






# Foxridge Improvement Association 2024 Annual Members Meeting By: Bryon Bhagwandin

Every November the Foxridge Improvement Association (FIA) has its annual members meeting. This year the meeting was fun, informative and delicious – thank you Tudi Arneill for the delicious treats at the meeting. The annual meeting is open to all FIA members and is also the time when election results for the Board of Directors are tabulated. The 2024 meeting was attended by all FIA board members, several members of the community, and three guest speakers. Because attendance did not reach the 10% membership threshold for a quorum, no resolution decisions requiring an official vote were made. This was an informal community meeting and discussion. Before highlighting the honored guests, let me share the results of the election. This year's ballot included five incumbent board members and one new candidate (Mark Trocinski). There were six open board seats and six candidates running. Each candidate was unanimously elected to the FIA board for a two-year term. Please join me in congratulating:

- Tudi Arneill
- Bryon Bhagwandin
- Alex Martinez
- Gurdeep Sandhu
- Mark Trocinski
- Andrew Yon

Now, turning attention to the guest speakers, attendees at the meeting heard presentations from Rick Holt, Centennial City Council Member, Deputy Dennis Meyer, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department, and Chad Clifford, Colorado House of Representatives. What a great group to hear from and discuss community concerns!

Deputy Dennis Meyer presented tips for neighborhood safety, automobile safety, and ID theft. The sheriff's office sponsors a neighborhood safety program entitled, Dog Walker Watch Program. If you are interested in getting involved, contact the FIA board or the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Department.

Below are some suggestions from the Department's Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design Program:

- Cut branches off trees near the house so 5 to 6 feet of trunk is visible
- Trim bushes and shrubs near the house down to 2 to 3 feet.
- Place motion sensor lights in areas of your property where strangers might hide.
- Light walkways on your property to identify where people should be on your property.
- Have good locks on your doors.
- Use three-inch screws on your door strike plates.

Deputy Meyer also informed us that Centennial is the third safest city in Colorado and is in the top ten safest cities in the country with more than 100,000 residents. We live in a great city!

Many of you already know our City Council member, Rik Holt. Rik has lived in Foxridge since 2001 and is a former FIA board member. Rik has been a member of the city council for three years and has a passion for public and community service. The City Council meets on the second

and fourth Tuesday of each month. On the off-weeks, they get together to study and educate themselves on the issues facing our community. A big shout-out to Rik for all the time, work, and energy he gives to make our city such a great place to live.

Did you know that Foxridge is home to one of our state representatives? Chad Clifford has been a Foxridge resident since 2013. He was first elected to the State House of Representatives a year ago and has already co-sponsored 140 bills! Chad has no particular agenda and tries to be as transparent as possible. At the meeting, he reported that his top priority right now is housing. Chad has invited anyone in the district to shadow him for a day at the capitol. He and his staff are equipped to provide such a service, and he wants you to know/see what he's doing for you. If this is something you are interested in, please reach out to his office – Chad Clifford, Colorado State Representative – District 37.

The Foxridge Improvement Association's Annual Members Meeting was a great success. We had a terrific line-up of speakers and a good group of attendees. It was a delightful time, coming together to learn about our community and the outstanding people who serve to make it all that it is. If you were unable to attend, know you were missed. Remember we have a members meeting every year on the second Wednesday of November; see you next year!

- Melt white chocolate and stir in peppermint extract. Spread it over dark chocolate layer.
- 3. Sprinkle with crushed peppermint candies and refrigerate until set. Break into pieces.






